

Marine Parade South Dune and Walkway Maintenance Communication

Dear Resident/Ratepayer

Dune and walkway maintenance is required along Marine Parade South to remove sand from the car park and existing walkways.


Auckland Council has worked together with Auckland Transport and Piha Coast Care to develop a plan to undertake this maintenance. Plans show where dune re-contouring and planting are planned to be undertaken and where walkways will be re-established using timber posts linked by 20mm polypropylene manila rope. Please refer to the plans which accompany this flyer.

The plans were assessed against the Piha Design Guidelines. The dune recontouring will reduce maintenance requirements and the fencing of the walkways was developed to reduce damage to the dune environment and provide public access to the beach.

Dune re-contouring works at the southern end of Marine Parade South commenced last week sooner than anticipated however, all works were undertaken in accordance with the plans approved by Auckland Council.

It is anticipated that the remaining works will commence the week of 4 July 2011 subject to weather conditions. Ongoing maintenance will be carried out as required.
