Seaview Road, Piha - Proposed Timber Edging

We are writing to you in response to the concerns that have been raised by the Piha Ratepayers and Residents' Association with regards to safety issues experienced by pedestrians when walking along Seaview Road, Piha.

At present, timber edging is provided on the southern side of Seaview Road to provide a walking area for pedestrians. The timber edging starts in the vicinity of the Piha Community Library and continues up to the western end of Seaview Road. However, a gap in the timber edging was provided east of the Piha Domain access way, to allow for vehicle parking. The pedestrian movement at this location was intended to move south from the road edge, through the grassed area, and connect back to the road edge west of Piha Domain access way. However, due to the existing planting at this location, pedestrians experience difficulty walking through this grass area.

Therefore, in order to provide a safe area for pedestrians to walk, Auckland Transport recommends extending the timber edging up to the Piha Domain accessway as shown in the attached diagram.

As part of the consultation process, feedback is being sought from those directly affected by the proposal. Please complete the attached form and return it in the reply paid envelope by 21 November 2015.
